



India launches World Castor Sustainability Forum for traceable supply chain

India, which produces about 20 lakh tonnes of castorseed per annum meeting over 90 per cent of the global demand for castor oil, has launched the World Castor Sustainability Forum (WCSF). This initiative aims to provide a sustainable and traceable supply chain of castor while improving economic, social, and environmental performance.

BV Mehra, Executive Director of the Solvent Extractors' Association of India (SEA), said the association spearheaded the formation of WCSF in response to the global shift towards renewable resources and the increasing emphasis on sustainability. This initiative is poised to enhance economic self-sufficiency and the livelihoods of smallholder producers.

Key players in the castor in-

dustry, including Adani Wilmar Ltd, Jayant Agro Organics Ltd, Gokul Overseas, Gokul Agro Resources Ltd, Royal Castor Products Ltd, NK Proteins Pvt Ltd, Castorgirnar Industries, along with traders, and service provider representatives joined WCSF in Ahmedabad.



He said the companies that embrace WCSF sustainability measures in line with the Indian Companies Act can experience improved brand reputation, competitive advantage, cost savings, access to capital, regulatory compliance, risk management, and long-term value creation.

30 FPOS TO JOIN

To promote the cultivation of sustainable castorseed, nearly 30 Farmer Producer Organizations (PPO), led by Gokul Overseas, Sidhpur, agreed to collaborate with WCSF on April 30. This collaboration represents approximately 25,000 farmers joining the movement in its inaugural year, committed to adopting the guidelines set forth by WCSF.

India's export of castor oil and derivatives are estimated above ₹12,000 crore (\$1.5 billion) per annum. The global castor derivatives market, which is estimated to be over \$4 billion per annum, is highly dependent on India.

World Sustainable Castor Standard

Two Types of Certifications



1. Production – Individual certification & Group certification

2. Chain of Custody – Supply Chain

Production Certification: This is a process that sets the standard for sustainable management of castor production, smallholdings and castor oil processing facilities. The certification process is run by an accredited third party certification body to assess and verify that the castor production management in compliance with the standards' requirements as prescribed in the WCSF standards. **Internal Control System (ICS)** can be formed to regulate the functioning and to maintain the internal quality of the group.

Chain of Custody – Supply Chain Certification: The WCSF Chain of Custody (CoC) module can be applied across the entire supply chain. It traces the path of castor products from farm through the supply chain.

Mass Balance

- MB module allows mixing of certified and non-certified products at any stage.
- The quantity of product processed is controlled. The input and output quantities shall be monitored at the site.
- Certified products delivered to the end user will be traceable to a list of WCSF certified mills.
- There are no requirement of separate storage, transportation or controls in the production process.
- MB accounting summary shall be maintained.



Segregation

- Segregation module does not allow mixing of certified and non-certified products at any stage of supply chain.
- The quantity of product processed is controlled. The input and output quantities should be monitored at the site.
- Certified products delivered to the end user will be traceable to a list of WCSF certified mills.
- The certified and non-certified product shall be kept separate at every stage of production, processing, storage, transportation.
- WCSF material accounting records shall be maintained.



Sustainable Credits

- 1 Sustainable credit is issued for 1 tonne of WCSF certified castor. (1 tonne castor = 1 credit)
- On product claim is not allowed.
- ICS shall maintain yield estimation data and actual harvested quantity.
- Certified mill shall maintain purchase record of credits.



WCSF - Certification Bodies



- ☐ All Certification Bodies that are internationally competent to carry out certification must first be approved by the WCSF
- ☐ This is necessary to ensure that certification bodies that conduct audits under the WCSF Certification are competent to carry out credible and consistent audits

Procedure for Membership



Determine Membership Type & Category (Client)

The submitted membership form is reviewed by the appropriate authority within the organization or forum to ensure that the applicant meets the eligibility criteria for membership.



Governance of SEA's WCSF



Governing Council:

There will be 11 members in the governing council. SEA (Solvent Extractors' Association of India) will facilitate elections to form the governing council. The governing council is the governing body of WCSF. It determines the policies and programs of WCSF and directs their implementation and conduct. The Governing Council is empowered to take all steps necessary to fulfill its function. The governing council is the ultimate decision-making body for all WCSF actions, including development, membership, and certification, etc. WCSF Secretariat and Advisory council will work under the guidance of the Governing council. The governing council shall be represented by farmers, crushers, derivative manufacturers, buyers, intermediaries, and other stakeholders. The chairman leads the governing council, with support from its members.

WCSF Secretariat:

The WCSF Secretariat has been created as the representative body for the WCSF. The WCSF Secretariat members will be recruited and appointed by the governing council. The number of members will be decided by the governing council.

Advisory Council:

The Advisory council comprises members from different sectors like Farming, Experts from Castor Supply Chain, Educational Institutions. Processing Industries, NGOs, and certification bodies.
